Both the Stewardson and Effingham Banking Centers are collecting plastic caps/lids that will be recycled and made into park benches to be placed throughout Stewardson. Please clean ALL caps/lids before donating and please make sure there are no extra items or trash in with the caps/lids.

One in five American children experience food insecurity - more than the populations of New York City, Los Angeles and Chicago combined. During the school week, most of these children depend on the federal free and reduced meal program their school offers. Sometimes, the meals at school are the only ones they get! When the school closes its doors on Friday afternoon, many of these children go home to empty cupboards and empty bellies for 65 hours until they return to school on Monday morning. Who will feed them this weekend? That is where "Blessings in a Backpack" comes in. Both the Stewardson and Effingham Banking Centers are collecting food items to help meet the needs of area children.
