The Museum features three galleries with 150 to 200 artifacts rotated 8 to 10 times per year. LOOKING BACK

At this time, when we've had major changes to our Classic 55 Events and trips, it has given me a chance to look back over the past four years. My first trip as a Classic 55 Coordinator for the Stewardson/Effingham area was to **PERE MARQUETTE** for **"Bald Eagle Viewing"** and lunch at **Finn Inn** followed by shopping in **Alton**. The weather was cold and rainy, but we had an awesome time, learned a great deal about Eagles, saw a few of them and enjoyed a delicious meal. That year we also took in **a St. Louis Cardinals game**, sharing a luxury suite with Classic 55 members from the Waterloo area. Our third trip in 2016 to Terre Haute will always be my most memorable, beginning with a tour of the **CLABBER GIRL MUSEUM** followed by lunch at **"The Bake Shop"**. Although, this was a great place to visit, our second stop at **Candles Holocaust Museum & Education Center** was truly unforgettable. **"CANDLES"** is an acronym for **"Children of Auschwitz Nazi Deadly Lab Experiment Survivors"**. We were able to tour the museum and then attended a lecture by **EVA MOZES KOR**, who founded the

organization and was, herself, a survivor of Auschwitz, along with her twin sister, MIRIAM MOZES ZIEGER. The Mozes sisters were able to locate 122 individual MENGELE TWINS living in 10 Countries and 4 Continents. Mrs. Kor gave us the details of her life before, during and after Auschwitz, and left such an impression on our hearts and minds! Sadly, Mrs. Kor passed away on July 4, 2019. Our last trip in 2016 was to ST. LOUIS & ST. CHARLES, which included a visit to the beautiful FOX THEATER to see "THE NUTCRACKER SUITE", which was amazing and St. Charles was so beautifully decorated for Christmas! I think my most memorable trip in 2017 was to NOAH'S ARK ENCOUNTER, CREATION MUSEUM & BEREA, KENTUCKY. We parked the motor coach and stepped on to the "ARK" bus. I will always remember coming to the top of the hill and seeing the GIANT ARK in front of us. It was magnificent and so worth the trip. The City of Berea was a trip back in time. It's a beautiful city built on the hills of Kentucky, covered in trees and is the "Folk Arts & Crafts" capital of the State.

My most memorable trip of 2018 was to the **COVERED BRIDGE FESTIVAL** in Parke County, Indiana. Upon arrival, we transferred from our luxury coach to two smaller coaches in order to tour several of the **Covered Bridges**. We had a delicious **"Buried Beef Meal"** and plenty of time to check out the many craft and food vendors along the way.

Last year we traveled to **Beef and Boards** to see "**GREASE**", which was amazing; to **ST. LOUIS**, touring the beautiful **MISSOURI BOTANICAL GARDENS** and several landmarks including the **ARCH** as well as the magnificent **ST. LOUIS CATHEDRAL BASILICA** and enjoying a delicious lunch at **FAVAZZAS** on **THE HILL**, St. Louis' Italian neighborhood. Last summer, some of our group travelled to **NOVA SCOTIA** where they had a great time and even travelled to and from the airport in a limousine. In August we went back to **ST. LOUIS** to cheer on the **CARDINALS** and finally made our way to BRANSON in November. The shows we saw were amazing and the food was delicious! I think what stands out the most in my mind was the warm hospitality we were shown everywhere we went. Hopefully we can return to **BRANSON** soon!
