TRIP ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Because of the changes in procedures, the number of trips being added in 2021 and how quickly trip information can change, we encourage you to sign up to receive the newsletter and updates by email. It will be the fastest way to receive up-to-date information. I realize not all of our members have access to electronic communication, so I encourage you to find a friend who can pass along the information.
- Trip information and updates will be released in our newsletter, by email and through our social media accounts. Watch your email and our Facebook Group for updates—it is the fastest way to disburse updates and new trips.
- We are adding an additional date to most trips to accommodate reduction in bus capacity and new travelers. Some of the trips will have a starting point of our Maryville location. If there is enough interest in a trip a third date may be added.

TRIP RESERVATIONS

- We have rebooked some of the cancelled trips from 2020 starting in March 2021. Our itineraries may slightly change with the venue statuses; review the details for changes.
- Original travelers will be given priority for all rescheduled trips.
- Classic 55 Club members are allowed to invite one friend along on a trip, but please realize there may be instances when an exclusive event or trip may necessitate members only. We encourage non-members to join the Classic 55 Club so they can receive all the benefits of membership (including receiving the newsletter and updates).

PAYMENTS AND REFUNDS

- Payment must be made at the reservation. Your seat will not be reserved until payment is made. The easiest payment
 option is to give the Classic 55 Coordinator permission to debit your Classic 55 account. Other payment options are mail
 or hand deliver payment to any banking center.
- Most reservations are transferable, meaning you can find someone to take your place or we will try to find a replacement from the standby list.
- Full payments can be refunded if cancellation is done before the posted cancellation date or a replacement traveler can be found.
- Sometimes there are non-recoverable costs that cannot be refunded, such as prepaid tickets, meal guarantees, final fees paid for motorcoach rentals or other trip fees that the vendors will not refund.
- Once you register, place all information on your personal calendar. Refunds cannot be issued for no-shows.
- Call or email the coordinator ASAP if you need to cancel your reservation.
- Once reservations are at capacity, a standby list is started.

NEW SAFETY PROTOCOLS

- Motorcoaches will be limited to 24 30 travelers. You can choose to sit with a friend or by yourself. Masks must be worn on the bus and there will be assigned seating. Please let us know if you need to sit towards the front of the bus and we will try to accommodate you the best we can.
- We do not REQUIRE you to complete a health/emergency contact form but encourage you to complete one for our file in the case of an emergency. We also suggest our travelers keep a list of current medications with them. This is purely for your safety. Please talk with the coordinator if you have any questions or concerns.
- We realize that the new protocols can be confusing but know that we are first concerned with the safety of our Classic 55 members. Please realize that these guidelines may need to be adjusted as we start to travel. We will keep you posted through the newsletter, our website and our Classic 55 Facebook Page and Group.

OTHER DETAILS

- Trips are casual and comfortable walking shoes are required for most trips. (See Sneaker Rating)
- All tips, meals, transportation and admission fees are included in price unless stated differently.

SNEAKER RATING

1 Sneaker = Easy, pace, mostly ramps, few or no stairs

4 Sneakers = Periods of intense pace, uneven terrain

2 Sneakers = Moderate pace, 1 slight of stairs, few inclines

5 Sneakers = Periods of strenuous pace, rough terrain

3 Sneakers = Steady pace, 1-2 flights of stairs, some inclines
