<u>Payment Options</u> – As of August 1, 2022 payment will be required to secure your reservation. Payment can be made by check, cash or debiting an FNB account. If you would like to hold off on payment until closer to the travel date, I can add you to the standby list & if there is space available you will be contacted for payment. Thank you for your patience & understanding.

Cancellations & Refund Process — Please contact Darcy as soon as possible if you need to cancel your reservation. The standby list will be utilized to fill any cancellations. If we cannot find a replacement, we will try to offer a full refund, but sometimes there are costs associated with our trips that have already been paid (i.e. live performance tickets, meals, prepaid tours). Therefore, we may only be able to refund a portion of your payment.

<u>Entrée Choices</u>—If entrées are listed in the trip description, please provide your choice when making your reservation.

<u>Sneaker Rating</u>—Please make sure to review our sneaker rating for each trip and call Darcy if you have concerns. Everyone must be able to climb the stairs to the motor coach without assistance. We want to make sure everyone is safe & can enjoy the destinations we visit. Safety Protocols—Masks are no longer required on the motor coach and we follow the masking protocol at each venue. We are still requiring travelers to provide proof that they are fully vaccinated <u>OR</u> a negative COVID PCR test given within 72 hours of the travel date. This is for all trips including day trips. Please submit a copy of your vaccination card. If you do not submit a copy, you will be required to show your card or negative PCR test prior to boarding the motor coach. We will keep monitoring the situation & keep you apprised of any changes.

"Person in need" scams

Scammers pose as a grandchild, relative or friend who claims to be ill, stranded in another state or foreign country, or otherwise in trouble, and ask you to send money. They may ask you to send cash by mail or buy gift cards. These scammers often beg you keep it a secret and act fast before you ask questions.

What to do: Don't panic! Take a deep breath and get the facts. Hang up and call your grandchild or friend's phone number to see if the story checks out. You could also call a different friend or relative. Don't send money unless you're sure it's the real person who contacted you.

What to do if you think you're being scammed

The best defense against scams is to **SAY NO** if anyone contacts you by phone, in person, by text message, or email and asks for your Social Security number, Bank account number, Credit card information, Medicare ID number, Drivers license number, any other personally identifiable information. Call (618) 939-6419 and ask for the Operations Department if you feel you have been or think someone is trying to scam you.

You can help keep those you care about from falling for a scam, regardless of their age or health status, by reporting any scams or suspected scams to the FTC.
