



# <u>Tuesday, April 16</u>

Board a deluxe motor coach this morning to begin our *worldwide tour* to **Omaha, NE!** After rest breaks and a lunch stop along the way, we arrive in Omaha late afternoon and check into the **Hyatt Place Downtown** hotel for three nights. Take time this evening to explore the historic **Old Market District** which has a variety of restaurants and unique shops quaintly spaced along brick streets with horse drawn carriage rides to get you from place-to-place. Discover the retro **Hollywood Candy warehouse** across from the hotel to see its large collection of 1960s and 70s memorabilia, retro diner, and antique pinball machine room.

# Wednesday, April 17 (Breakfast, Snack, Dinner)

After breakfast at the hotel we'll visit the **Holy Family Shrine**, a glass chapel overlooking the scenic Platte Valley. Upon our arrival we will enter the Visitor's Center to learn about its visionaries and construction. Our next stop is **Ireland** located on the expansive campus of **Boys Town**, a National Historic Landmark District. Inside this world-renowned village are the Hall of History museum, historic chapels, gardens, and Father Flanagan's 1920s home. It's the stuff that movies are made of - *Boys Town*, the 1938 movie starring Spencer Tracey and Mickey Rooney, won two Academy Awards and one of them is on display in the Hall of History. Lunch will be on your own at the **Boys Town Cafe**. Next we're visiting **India** to see the elaborate and striking **Hindu Temple**, featuring beautiful hand-carved elephants and religious figures. Discover basic information about the Hindu faith as it relates to the symbolic expression in the temple.

Savor a taste of the **Czech Republic** with kolache pastries and coffee as we visit the **Omaha Czech and Slovak Cultural Museum.** While enjoying our treats we'll learn aboutCzech culture, hear a local accordion player perform, and then visit the gift shop, which features hand-decorated eggs and jewelry. Then we'll head back to the Old Market for a break before visiting **Poland** this evening. We'll visit the **Polish Heritage Society of Nebraska** where we'll enjoy a traditional meal with live accordion music. We'll also learn about Omaha's Polish community. Our trip to **Ireland** continue from this morning with a special dance presentation from Marty Dowd's Irish Dance group and a variety of live music from Irish musician Dave Marsh.







# Thursday, April 18 (Breakfast, Snack, Lunch, Dinner)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before we travel to **Lithuania** for an inspirational visit. Through the eyes of the owners of the **Lithuanian Bakery** we'll hear how the Machevicius family escaped Germany in WWII and moved to Omaha to start a bakery business. Taste some of their famous breads and enjoy their signature dessert which takes three days to make! Next we'll experience an hour-long close-up encounter with hawks and owls at the **Fontenelle Forest Nature Center** as professional educators exhibit these magnificent birds and explain their unique features firsthand. Then discover the **Raptor Woodland Refuge** to see 16 non-releasable raptors, including a Gyrfalcon, Ferruginous hawk, and two bald eagles.

This afternoon we travel to **Greece** for a tour of **St. John's Greek Orthodox Church**. In this beautiful gold-dome Byzantine church we'll hear about the history of Orthodox Christianity, Byzantine iconography, vestments, architecture and traditions. A delicious Greek lunch and dessert will be served and there will be lessons in Greek culture and dancing! Our next stop will showcase the history of Omaha as we tour the **Durham Museum** located in Omaha's historic 1930s Union Station. Enjoy touring a restored passenger train car and historical Omaha storefronts before stopping at their restored 1940's soda fountain to enjoy a phosphate soda or malt. We'll then return to the hotel to freshen up.

For dinner, we're headed south of the border to **Mexico**! Enjoy an authentic Mexican meal at **Fernado's** Cafe. Following dinner we'll see a performance of traditional dances by the colorfully costumed Chomari Ballet Folklorico dance group at **El Museo Latino**, the first Latino art and history museum in the Midwest. Take time to explore the exhibits on Latino history and visit the museum gallery to see works by Latino artists.

# Friday, April 19 (Breakfast, Snack)

After breakfast we'll continue our "world tour" with a visit to the **Ukrainian Assumption Catholic Church of Byzantine Rite** where Olesia Reprichowskyj will show us a traditional linen beautifully embroidered, passed down from generation to generation. Enjoy coffee and Ukrainian pastries as we tour the picturesque church and hear Olesia's inspirational story of growing up in Ukraine during World War II. After the presentation take time to browse the Ukrainian items for sale. All proceeds will go to purchase medicine for villages in Ukraine. With this trip at an end, we'll depart for home a few pounds heavier and with a new understanding of the eight countries that we visited - all without a passport!
