Important Details

<u>Securing Multi-Day Tour Reservations</u>— Reservations are secured with submission of necessary documents **and** the deposit. First come, first registered. If you have not submitted documents and your deposit, your space has not been reserved.

<u>Cancellations & Refund Process</u>— Please contact Darcy as soon as possible to cancel your reservation. The stand by list will be utilized to try and fill your reservation. **Feel free to contact friends or family to take your spot.** If we cannot find a replacement, a refund will be given in the amount returned from our tour company, usually live performance tickets, meals, prepaid activities & tours are non-refundable.

Motorcoach Seating—Motorcoach seating is on the first come, first seated basis. Assigned/reserved seating will be at the front of the coach for those travelers who have mobility or medical issues. Please mention your needs when making your reservation. Otherwise it is first come/first seated. Remember access to the coach will start 15 minutes prior to departure. In Waterloo, please wait for the bank representative to invite you to load the coach.

<u>Payment Options</u>—Payment is required to secure your day trip reservation. Payment can be made by check, cash or debiting an FNB account.

<u>Entrée Choices</u>—If entrées are listed in the trip description, please provide your choice when making your reservation. Also, please give any food allergies or meal restrictions (i.e.: gluten free, vegetarian, vegan)

Newsletters — Our newsletters are published & mailed to be received on the 1st day of the odd numbered months of the year (January, March, May etc.) If you do not receive your copy by the 5th of the month, feel free to ask for a copy at your local banking center or go to our Classic 55 Club page www.fnbwaterloo.bank/55-club/ to view online. If you would like to receive your newsletter by email only, please contact Darcy with your email address.

Energizer Park is the home of St. Louis CITY SC and reflects many of St. Louis' most amazing attributes, including its diverse neighborhoods, growing culinary scene, innovative technology, inviting community and a spirit of a new St. Louis. Lunch today will be enjoyed Sqwires Restaurant in Lafayette Square. Housed in a restored 19th-century factory, it combines original architectural elements with modern decor. Known for its seasonal, locally sourced menu, SqWires serves a variety of options. Today you will have a limited menu to choose from, please pre-select from a choice of: Spinach Salad, Burger, Chicken Salad Sandwich, Turkey Reuben or Veggie Lasagna. Our afternoon starts with a tour St. Louis Public Library's Central Library. Designed by renowned architect Cass Gilbert and completed in 1912, the structure which occupies a full city block is a historic treasure. Exquisite replicas of features from the Pantheon, Vatican and Michelangelo's Laurentian Library bring the Italian Renaissance to life in the heart of downtown St. Louis. We finish the afternoon with a tour at the 21C Hotel, which reimagines a historic St. Louis fixture: the 10story, Renaissance Revival-style YMCA building. Located in the heart of downtown St. Louis, 21c Museum Hotel St. Louis includes a 173-room boutique hotel and a contemporary art museum. With more than 14,000 square feet of exhibition and meeting & event space seamlessly integrated into all areas of the property, there are opportunities to discover contemporary art around every corner.
