Wednesday, April 15 (Breakfast, Box Lunch, Dinner)



This afternoon we check into the elegant **Inn at Biltmore Estate** for two nights. Get settled in your exquisitely appointed room at this four-star hotel situated in the breathtaking Blue Ridge Mountains of North Carolina. Then meet your traveling companions for a **gourmet dinner** at the Inn. Dining has always been cause for celebration at the Biltmore and remains a cherished tradition. A talented culinary staff adheres to a "field-to-table" concept that draws from the Biltmore's harvest from surrounding gardens, fields, orchards, and vineyards. The estate's ten-acre Kitchen Garden yields dozens of varieties of fresh produce, estate-raised beef and lamb, local honey, and award-winning Biltmore wines.

Thursday, April 16 (Breakfast, Dinner)

After breakfast, we will explore the magnificent **Biltmore Estate** during this most lovely time of year, when the gardens are bursting with springtime color. We begin as an Estate Ambassador joins us en route to the house, sharing with us information about the property, landscape, architecture, and the vision of George Vanderbilt. Upon arrival at the Biltmore House, an included 90-minute **audio tour** gives the feeling of being guided through Biltmore's grand rooms by their curators. We'll learn about the Vanderbilts, their guests, and their servants, in addition to the surrounding architecture, design, and artwork. This 250-room, 19th- century French Renaissance château remains America's largest privately owned home. Outside the home, immerse yourself in the thousands of colorful blooms that transform the formal and informal gardens and grounds in the springtime.

We'll visit the estate's **Antler Hill Village**, which connects the Biltmore's present and past. This village provides a relaxing place for dining, shopping, historical exhibits, and new ways to experience Biltmore's hospitality - such as



a complimentary wine tasting! The gracious wine hosts are happy to guide you through a tasting of robust reds, refreshing rosés, and crisp whites. You will have time to have lunch at one the village's many restaurants.

Mid-afternoon we depart for downtown **Asheville** - known as an art colony, a healing resort, and home to notable statesmen and luminaries. Asheville is one of the most welcoming, vibrant cities in America! We will be joined by a **local guide** who will acquaint us with this fascinating city. Our tour will include the **Asheville Folk Art Center**, which showcases the finest in traditional and contemporary crafts of the Southern Appalachians.

We will enjoy dinner this evening at **Stone Ridge Tavern** before returning to our hotel on the Biltmore Estate.

Friday, April 17 (Breakfast, Lunch, Kickback Reception)
After another wonderful breakfast, we say farewell to the Biltmore Estate and make our way to **Dollywood** in **Pigeon**Forge, TN. Known for its live stage shows, the Dolly Museum, train rides, the American Eagle habitat, and (for the very brave) the Wild Eagle Coaster, you're sure to have a fun day at the park! Within short walking distance you may visit the Sutton General Store, Mayberry - I Love Lucy Museum, Pioneer Village, Sutton Homestead, Car Museum and many more! Enjoy lunch on your own in this quaint town.
