

### Danube Delights River Cruise with Oktoberfest





**DAY 1** Depart the USA: Depart the USA on your overnight flight to Budapest, Hungary.

DAY 2 Budapest, Hungary: Upon arrival, you will be met by a local representative and transferred to the ship, home for the next seven nights. The afternoon is at leisure to become acquainted with the ship or begin exploring the city on your own. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a traditional Hungarian dinner and authentic Hungarian folklore show onboard. Meal: D

DAY 3 Budapest: Today's included tour presents you with a fantastic opportunity to become acquainted with Hungary's beautiful capital. See the Hungarian Parliament Building, Heroes' Square, and Andrassy Avenue – a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Alternatively, enjoy a guided hike to Gellert Hill for a postcard-worthy panorama of the Danube banks. This afternoon, the ship departs for Bratislava. Meals: B, L, D

DAY 4 Bratislava, Slovakia: This morning, relax onboard as the ship sails to Bratislava. Witness Bratislava Castle, perched atop a hill, as you arrive into port. During the guided walking tour, meander through the heart of the city as you view the lavish Episcopal Summer Palace, the neo-Renaissance façade of the Slovak National Theater, and charming streets lined with quaint shops and cafés. Alternatively, choose to join the hike to the castle for a look around the gardens and overview of the Danube. This afternoon, a highlight of the day will be a home-hosted visit where you are treated to tasty homemade specialties in the home of local Slovakians. What a unique opportunity to meet the locals and learn about life in Slovakia! Meals: B, L, D

DAY 5 Vienna, Austria: Welcome to Vienna, the capital of classical music and world-famous art exhibitions. Today you have a choice of activities: explore Austria's art history on an

included tour featuring a visit to the Kunsthistorisches Museum, the largest art museum in the country and one of the most important museums in the world. OR, explore on two wheels with a bike ride along the river, arriving at Danube Island.

Meals: B, L, D

DAY 6 Dürnstein: This morning sail along the river and through the UNESCO World Heritage Wachau Valley en route to Dürnstein. Enjoy time at leisure in this charming village, known as "The Pearl of the Wachau Valley". This afternoon, depart on a guided tour of Gottweig Abbey, one of Austria's most important Benedictine abbeys. Sitting atop a hill near Krems, this architectural treasure overlooks the UNESCO World Heritage Wachau Valley. Alternatively, cycle past the terraced vineyards and castles as you join a guided bike tour.

Meals: B, L, D

DAY 7 Passau, Germany: After a relaxing morning onboard, the ship arrives in Passau where cobblestone streets and graceful arcades welcome you. On an included walking tour of this city on the confluence of the Danube, Inn and Ilz Rivers, stroll through the old town's narrow alleyways and see its noteworthy architecture. St. Stephen's Cathedral is a wonderful example of Baroque architecture and home to Europe's largest pipe organ with more than 17,000 pipes. After a bit of free time, return to the ship for a leisurely sailing along the river to Regensburg. Meals: B, L, D

DAY 8 Regensburg: A morning arrival in Regensburg brings you to one of Germany's best-preserved medieval cities and home to one of the oldest bridges crossing the Danube. As a local guide leads you through cobblestone lanes on a walking tour, discover the UNESCO World Heritage city center and see many of the city's architectural highlights. Enjoy a Bavarian sausage tasting during the tour for a real 'taste' of local life! Alternatively, join a bike tour to the Walhalla Monument,



towering high above the slopes of the Danube. The site affords a fascinating view of the surrounding landscape and the river below. This evening, a traditional Bavarian band performs onboard. The ship remains docked in Regensburg overnight.

Meals: B. L. D

DAY 9 Regensburg – Munich: After breakfast, say goodbye to your Captain and crew as you disembark your ship and depart by motorcoach for Munich. Upon arrival, an included panoramic tour showcases the former Olympic site, Nymphenburg Palace, Maximillianstrasse and the Parliament, the National Theater and Munich's Residenz. During a walking tour, stroll through Marienplatz Square and see the famous Glockenspiel. Enjoy the festive atmosphere of Oktoberfest with an included entrance to a beer tent at the fairground. Of course a sampling of the local beer and food will be served while partaking in the merriment of the music and fun in the tent.

Meal: B, snack at Oktoberfest

**DAY 10** Munich: Your final day is left free of planned activities to pursue individual interests. Continue discovering the sights of the city, shopping for last minute souvenirs, or return to the Oktoberfest fairgrounds independently. **Meal: B** 

DAY 11 Munich / USA: Bid a fond farewell to Europe and return home with wonderful memories of life enriching experiences from your cruise along the Danube River. **Meal: B**







## Classic 55 Club & Mayflower Cruises & Tours Travel General Information



The Mayflower overall activity level of this tour is level 3, which translates to a Level 5+ Classic 55 Club Sneaker Rating. Health and Walking Tours: Some sites may require significant walking, climbing stairs, or navigating inclines. Staying on the motorcoach and skipping the visit may not always be an option. Additionally, some destinations are located at higher elevations, which can cause altitude sickness and may exacerbate pre-existing conditions such as heart disease, lung problems, or respiratory issues. Therefore, travelers should be in reasonably good health. Please note that tour managers and drivers cannot lift or assist travelers into vehicles and are not permitted to push wheelchairs. Mayflower Cruises & Tours requires that passengers who require assistance be accompanied by a traveling companion who is fully capable of providing the necessary support.

<u>Travel Protection:</u> First National Bank of Waterloo has always believed in the importance of Trip Protection Plans. Our tour pricing **DOES NOT** represent cost with trip protection although we do encourage our travelers to protect their trip. For travelers who have purchased Mayflower Cruises & Tours' Traveler Protection Plan (TPP), please note that your insurance policy provides coverage for various incidents during your trip. These include accidental death and dismemberment, trip delay, medical expense and emergency assistance, loss or damage of baggage and travel documents and baggage delay. While on tour, you can contact the Trip Mate Insurance Company for any claim-related questions at 1-833-297-2255. This number is answered 24 hours daily. <u>Methods of Payment:</u> We accept cash, check or debit from a First National Bank of Waterloo account. The travel provider may accepts credit card payment and there could be a handling fee.

<u>Cancellations</u>: Our cancellation fees vary according to the type of tour. Your deposit is refundable up to the final payment due date unless previously noted. If you need to cancel for a covered reason after final payment, you may file a claim with proper documentation to request refund. Please review the Cancellation Policy listed on the brochure for specific details.

<u>Tour Inclusions:</u> Classic 55 Club tour cost includes all attractions, lodging, motor coach transportation, meals as noted and gratuities for all included for any events or services provided. If the trip includes airfare, the cost of the ticket is included unless otherwise noted. Some airlines charge for checked baggage, which is <u>not included</u> in the tour price unless noted.

<u>Itinerary Changes:</u> From time to time, circumstances require changes in the order of events or attractions visited. Your Tour Manager will announce any changes.

<u>Motor Coach Pick Up Locations:</u> All pick up points allow parking for your vehicle. Please park in the specified area of the parking lot as not to disrupt usual business. Neither First National Bank of Waterloo nor the parking lot owners assume responsibility for incidents occurring to parked cars.

The motor coach usually originates from the Waterloo VFW, 406 Veteran's Drive. Please park in the west parking lot of the VFW, taking care not to block the trash dumpster. Columbia pick up is at Schnuck's Marketplace, 1000 Columbia Center, park towards the road, near the Post Office. The motor coach will pull up to the sidewalk of the post office. Please bring your luggage to the motor coach to be loaded. Meeting the group at the airport is also an option.

<u>Motorcoach Seating:</u> Special seating requests are based on medical need and availability. Seating at the front of the coach due to medical needs will be limited to the traveler and their travel partner. If you are traveling with a group, they may be seated separately.

<u>Seat Rotation Guideline:</u> Mayflower Cruises & Tours requires its tour managers to administer a daily seat rotation program to allow each traveler an equal opportunity for viewing the sights from different perspectives and give to everyone the opportunity to become acquainted with fellow travelers as you circulate throughout the motorcoach. We expect your cooperation in adhering to our seat rotation policy. Exemptions to the seat rotation requirement will only be considered for passengers who provide a doctor's note stating the need for such. Please note that the seats in the first row of the coach are reserved exclusively for tour managers and step on guides.

<u>Transportation Information:</u> No matter what tour you are traveling on, we do all we can to make your trip rewarding and enjoyable. To prevent injury, please remain seated while the motorcoach is in motion. If you find it necessary to move around, please do so carefully, holding on to the seatbacks of the coach. For the protection of all passengers please be extremely careful when removing your carry-on bag, or other stored items, from the overhead rack. Your driver maintains the temperature of the coach for the comfort of all passengers. Since individual thermostats vary, you may want to bring a sweater along while traveling.

<u>Cellular Telephone Usage:</u> We understand the need to stay in touch with family and friends back home. However, we do request that you please refrain from using cellular telephones while on the coach. This will enable you and your traveling companions to receive full enjoyment from the tour.

<u>No Smoking or Alcohol Please:</u> Mayflower Cruises & Tours has a no-smoking policy on the motorcoach including e-cigarettes. Additionally, Alcohol consumption is not allowed on the motorcoach. Frequent rest and meal stops are made, providing ample time for those who wish to smoke. Observance of this requirement helps ensure the wellbeing of all members of the tour.

Guaranteed Share Program for Single Travelers: If you are traveling alone and would like a roommate for cost savings, let us know at the time of booking your reservation. Travelers must be non-smokers, cannot use a medical sleeping device or have specific needs like Handicapped room etc. to be eligible. Participants will be paired with another traveler of the same gender at the twin rate. If no roommate is available, you will get a single room at the twin rate. Guaranteed share reservations are available 180 days prior to tour departure. Guaranteed share reservations are only available on certain Cabin categories. Please call us for details.

Roommate Cancellation: If you are booked as a "twin" and your roommate cancels their reservation, and you cannot find another roommate, you may either travel as a guaranteed share (see above) or travel as a single and pay the single supplement.
