This tour will sell out fast. We currently have almost 70 customers interested in this trip that will only accommodate 42 travelers, which include only 4 single travelers. **For this reason, this trip will be available to Classic 55 Club accountholders first.** You may have a non-member as your travel partner. If you do not currently have a Classic 55 Club account, you must open one prior to processing your registration. **Reservations will be on a first-come, first registered basis. When we have filled all available spots, we will start a waiting list.**

The following items are required to secure your booking:

1. Completed Booking & Traveler Information Form.
2. \$1,100 deposit + insurance cost (if applicable) per person.
 - a. Debit authorization, cash or check made payable to FNB.
 - b. Credit card payment is not available for this tour.
3. A copy of your passport(s) or driver's license if applying for passport.

Important Notes:

- Please drop documents off at any of our banking centers, or scan, and email to dfausz@fnbwaterloo.bank or mail to FNB – Classic 55, Post Office Box 507, Waterloo, IL 62298. When received, your registration will be date and time stamped.
- Processing will occur when we receive your deposit & the required items. If you have traveled with us previously, we may have your identification and Emergency Information on file.
- We will notify you no later than September 17th if your reservation has been accepted or if you have been added to the waiting list. The waiting list will be utilized when cancellations occur.

Tentative Air Schedule on Lufthansa nonstop flights from St Louis to Frankfurt

August 16, 2026, depart St Louis at 3:30 pm arrive in Frankfurt 7:25 am August 17.

August 28, 2026, depart Frankfurt 10:40am arrive St Louis 1:30pm

Travel Protection: First National Bank of Waterloo has always believed in the importance of Trip Protection Plans. Our tour pricing **DOES NOT** represent cost with trip protection although we do encourage our travelers to protect their trip.

We strongly suggest that our guests purchase travel protection. While it can be added at any point up until final payment it must be added within 2 weeks of the reservation booking date to cover any pre-existing conditions. For coverage details:

affinitytravelcert.com/docs/GFB01 If you choose not to purchase the Insurance Plan, you could incur penalties for changes and cancellations. Travel Protection Payment is due with first deposit. When you purchase Travel Protection, you also receive the "Any Reason" Cancellation Waiver that allows you to cancel your Globus family of brands arrangements before your scheduled trip departure for any reason not eligible by the Trip Cancellation Waiver provisions. When a cancellation that is not eligible by the Trip Cancellation Waiver provisions occurs during a penalty period, your cancellation penalty will be refunded in future Travel Certificates, with the balance of the refund made either in cash or by credit card credit. Please note: The "Any Reason" Cancellation Waiver does not reimburse penalties associated with air or other travel arrangements not provided by Globus family of brands.

Final Payment: Final payments are due 45 - 60 days prior to departure depending on the trip, please consult the trip brochure to review specific tour details.

Methods of Payment: We accept cash, check or debit from a First National Bank of Waterloo account. The travel provider may accept credit card payment and there could be a handling fee.

Cancellations: Our cancellation fees vary according to the type of tour. Your deposit is refundable up to the final payment due date unless previously noted. If you need to cancel for a covered reason after final payment, you may file a claim with proper documentation to request a refund. Please review the Cancellation Policy listed in the brochure for specific details.

Tour Inclusions: Classic 55 Club tour cost includes all attractions, lodging, motor coach transportation, meals as noted and gratuities for all included for any events or services provided. If the trip includes airfare, the cost of the ticket is included unless otherwise noted. Some airlines charge for checked baggage, which is not included in the tour price unless noted. Upgraded seating may be requested and full payment will be required to guarantee the pricing. Airfare price will include one free check bag and seat assignments.

Motor Coach Pick Up Locations: All pick up points allow parking for your vehicle. Please park in the specified area of the parking lot so as not to disrupt the usual business. Neither First National Bank of Waterloo nor the parking lot owners assume responsibility for incidents occurring to parked cars.

The motor coach usually originates from the Waterloo VFW, 406 Veteran's Drive. Please park in the west parking lot of the VFW, taking care not to block the trash dumpster. Columbia pick-up is at Schnuck's Marketplace, 1000 Columbia Center, park towards the road, near the Post Office. The motor coach will pull up to the sidewalk of the post office. Please bring your luggage to the motor coach to be loaded. Meeting the group at the airport is also an option. If there are enough travelers from another location, another pick-up could be added. Please contact Darcy with any questions.

Motorcoach Seating: Special seating requests are based on medical need and availability. Seating at the front of the coach due to medical needs will be limited to the traveler and their travel partner. If you are traveling with a group, they may be seated separately.

Single Travelers requesting roommates: If you would like to travel with The Classic 55 Club, but do not have a roommate for a specific trip, let the coordinator know when you complete the reservation process and they can provide you with the names of other travelers of the same sex who are also looking for a roommate. If there is a mutual agreement to room together, you will be charged the double rate. Of course, if you prefer to travel individually, you can still register for single occupancy.

Trip Registration after Final Payment: Often there is room for additional travelers after the final payment date. Contact the coordinator. Please be aware that additional charges may apply when booking after the final payment date. We are happy to advise you of such changes before you finalize your reservation.

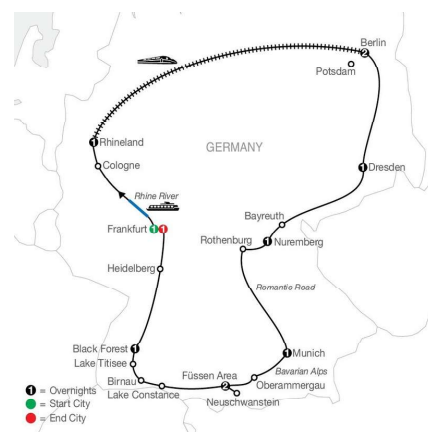

Day 3: Frankfurt-Cologne-Rhineland

Day 4: Rhineland-Berlin

Board the high-speed ICE train to Berlin. Guided sightseeing includes the Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial Church and picture stops at Brandenburg Gate and the Holocaust Memorial.

Day 5: Berlin

Enjoy a free day to explore Berlin.

Day 6: Berlin-Dresden

Enjoy free time for lunch. An orientation walk features the Zwinger Palace Courtyard.

Day 7: Dresden-Bayreuth-Nuremberg

Day 11: Füssen Area-Lindau-Birbau-Lake Titisee-Black Forest

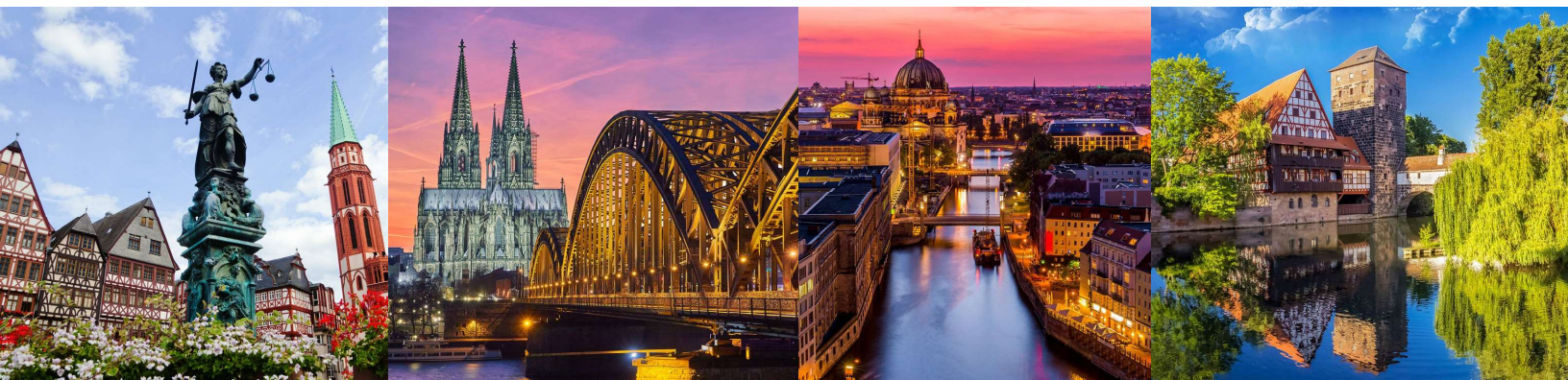
