October 20-23, 2026

Come see some of the best works of American Art in a brand-new gallery designed just for this purpose! Alice Walton used the Walmart fortune to bring incredible works of art to the South, put on display for the public to see. From Norman Rockwell's *Rosie the Riveter* to Winslow Homer's *Spring* you will be astonished at the collection that's less than a day's travel from home! A highlight is touring a Frank Lloyd Wright house on the property.

### Tuesday, Oct 20, 2026

As we begin our journey by heading west, along I-44, following the course of the famous Route 66. We'll take a break along the way and enjoy lunch at one of Dea's favorites, **Sybill's** in St. James. Enjoy a plated lunch and then shopping at her boutique. We then head south into Arkansas, arriving at the **Embassy Suites** for their **Happy Hour**. Tonight, dine at Mermaids Seafood House with a choice of 4 entrees to be pre-selected. (**L, Happy Hour, D**)

### Wednesday, Oct 21

Enjoy our included hot, cooked to order breakfast at the hotel before we visit a homegrown artist haven, **Terra Studios**! A collection of art studios with numerous artists in residence tucked away into the woods, Terra Studios is the home of the *Original Blue Bird of Happiness* made famous by Hallmark! After a tour of their Art Park and Garden, we

will see an artist creating right before our eyes. (Based on availability) This visit will get you prepared for taking in all the diverse types of art tomorrow at Crystal Bridges. We then head down to Van Buren, Arkansas for a quick bite to eat and to ride the rails on the **A&M Railroad**. Arkansas & Missouri Railroad's special passenger train services offer you 'A Window Seat to History' -- an opportunity to travel in the style of a bygone era. You can still enjoy the leisurely elegance of real train travel through the mountains and valleys of Northwest Arkansas. Over trestles with views for miles and through a quarter mile tunnel, your journey will take you all the way to the top of the scenic Boston Mountains and into the historic Arkansas River Basin. We arrive at Springdale station where our motorcoach meets us to return to the hotel to enjoy Happy Hour before we head down to the Catfish Hole in Fayetteville for those that want to have a dinner out after the Happy Hour. You'll be sure to find some fine southern cooking here

with a large choice from fish to chicken to beef. (**B, L**)

### Thursday, Oct 22

Enjoy our included hot, cooked to order breakfast at the hotel before visiting the highlight of our tour at opening time - **Crystal Bridges Art Museum**! Enjoy an afternoon wandering the curving halls of this incredible museum, featuring such well known works as Asher Durand's *Kindred Spirits* and Andy Warhol's *Dolly Parton*, just some of the many treasures awaiting your gazing pleasure at the gathering place of five centuries of American masterpieces. Or take a stroll through the outdoor sculptures along the walking paths on the grounds as well. Lunch will be on your own at Eleven or Bars & Bites located in the Museum. Enjoy yourself as long as you like. **Let us know at time of reservation if you want to tour the frank Lloyd Wright home on property and we will secure tickets**. We will run two shuttles to the hotel this afternoon. We then return to the hotel to enjoy Happy Hour before heading to a local Arkansas favorite for a family style fried chicken dinner. (**B, D, Happy Hour**)

### Friday, Oct 23

After breakfast we visit the wonderfully quaint Bentonville downtown, home to numerous shops as well as the Walmart Welcome Center, a museum focused on the origin of the largest retailer in the world. There is even an AI generated Sam Walton available to answer your questions. We then head to tour **Peel Mansion Museum and Heritage Gardens**. Built in 1875 by Colonel Samuel West Peel, this amazing Italianate Mansion features amazing woodwork, particularly the walnut stairway in the front hall. There are numerous other styles found in the home as well, including a rare Anglo-Japanese mantle in the library and Greek Revival molded trim in the parlor, and the museum has collected period appropriate pieces to furnish the house in the grand Victorian Style in which it was designed. This attention to detail extends to the gardens, where paintings, photographs and even interviews with those descended from the early settlers were interviewed for what the gardens would have been like in the late 1800s. We depart and stop for lunch & shopping on your own at Branson Landing before returning home this evening. (**B**)

### Trip Protection:

### Final Payment:

Final payments are due 45 - 60 days prior to departure depending on the trip, please consult the trip brochure to review specific tour details.

### Methods of Payment:

We accept cash, check or debit from a First National Bank of Waterloo account. The travel provider may accept credit card payment and there could be a handling fee.

### Cancellations:

Our cancellation fees vary according to the type of tour. Your deposit is refundable up to the final payment due date unless previously noted. If you need to cancel for a covered reason after final payment, you may file a claim with proper documentation to request refund. Please review the Cancellation Policy listed in the brochure for specific details.

### Tour Inclusions:

Classic 55 Club tour costs include all attractions, lodging, motor coach transportation, meals as noted and gratuities for all included events or services provided.

### Motor Coach Pick Up Locations:

All pick up points allow parking for your vehicle. Please park in the specified area of the parking lot so as not to disrupt usual business. Neither First National Bank of Waterloo nor the parking lot owners assume responsibility for incidents occurring to parked cars.

The motor coach usually originates from the Waterloo VFW, 406 Veteran's Drive. Please park in the west parking lot of the VFW, taking care not to block the trash dumpster. Columbia pick up is at Schnuck's Marketplace, 1000 Columbia Center, park towards the road, near the Post Office. The motor coach will pull up to the sidewalk of the post office. Please bring your luggage to the motor coach to be loaded.

### Motorcoach Seating:

Please leave the front row on each side of the coach open for the tour director, escort and step on guides.

Special seating requests are made regarding medical need and availability. Seating at the front of the coach due to medical needs will be limited to the traveler and their travel partner. If you are traveling with a group, they may be seated separately.

### Single Travelers requesting roommates:

If you would like to travel with The Classic 55 Club, but do not have a roommate for a specific trip, let the coordinator know when you complete the reservation process and they can provide you with the names of other travelers of the same sex who are also looking for a roommate. If there is mutual agreement to room together, you will be charged double rate. Of course, if you prefer to travel individually, you can still register for single occupancy.
