Travel by rail through the Rocky Mountains with its majestic peaks rising nearly 7,000-feet in the sky. Experience the dramatic landscapes and towering sandstone formations at Monument Valley. Cruise on serene Lake Powell, and stand in absolute awe at the edge of the massive Grand Canyon. Complete your western experience in America's most beautiful western town, Sedona!



TUESDAY, JUNE 1 (KICKBACK RECEPTION)

Fly with us to **Denver, CO** where we will begin our *Rockies to Red Rocks* adventure! On arrival, we will check into the **Drury Inn & Suites Central Park**. Tonight, enjoy the hotel's **Kickback Reception** with hot food and cold drinks.

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 2 (BREAKFAST, LUNCH)

This morning we transfer to Denver's Union Station to experience the Rocky Mountaineer's newest rail journey, **Rockies to Red Rocks aboard the Canyon Spirit!** Breakfast and lunch are served on the train. On our all-daylight rail tour we'll witness extraordinary landscapes including vast canyons, natural archways and enchanting hoodoos. Today we cross the Continental Divide while cutting through 6.3 miles of the engineering marvel, the Moffat Tunnel. Later, our course follows the Colorado River through rugged Glenwood Canyon, before arriving in **Glenwood Springs, CO**. We will overnight at a Glenwood Springs hotel.



THURSDAY, JUNE 3 (BREAKFAST, DINNER)

It's "all aboard" this morning at the Glenwood Springs train station for our **second day on the Canyon Spirit** as we continue our journey west. Breakfast is served on board. We cross the Colorado-Utah border with stunning mountain views in the background. Gorgeous red sandstone landscapes emerge as we approach **Moab, UT**. Explore charming downtown Moab this afternoon with its plentiful dining options and myriad of shops. Later, we check into the **Springhill Suites** for the night. Tonight, we'll enjoy dinner at **Zax's Restaurant**.



FRIDAY, JUNE 4 (BREAKFAST, BOX LUNCH, DINNER)

After breakfast at the hotel we'll make our way to our put-in spot for a **raft trip** on the **Colorado River**. Our adventure will take us from the epic vistas of red sandstone monuments and mesas into magnificent canyons with 320 million years of geologic history. Keep your eyes peeled for bighorn sheep on the steep cliffs! Afterward, we depart Moab and head south into the desert-west landscapes of Arizona. We'll drive by iconic **Monument Valley, AZ** with its fragile pinnacles surrounded by miles of mesas and buttes. Later tonight, we arrive at **Glen Canyon National Recreation Area**, the official name for **Lake Powell**, and check into the **Lake Powell Resort & Marina** for the night. We'll enjoy dinner at the resort, complete with panoramic lake views.



SATURDAY, JUNE 5 (BREAKFAST, DINNER)

A delicious breakfast buffet is included at the hotel this morning before we head out on our **Lake Powell boat cruise**. We'll cruise through Wahweap Bay to Glen Canyon Dam, the second largest concrete arch dam in the United States, for a perfect combination of breathtaking views and fascinating history

After our cruise, we leave Lake Powell and make our way to one of the Seven Natural wonders of the World, the **Grand Canyon!** Upon arrival at **Grand Canyon National Park**, we'll make a couple of photo stops before checking in for one night at the **Yavapai Lodge** in Grand Canyon Village. Our lodge is located only a half mile from the rim and along the free Village Shuttle Bus route. The evening is yours to spend as you wish; stroll along the Rim Trail, soak in the amazing views, stop by the Visitor's Center to explore exhibits about the history and geology of the park or shop for souvenirs in one of the many gift shops. You'll receive a voucher to enjoy dinner at our lodge at your leisure.

SUNDAY, JUNE 6 (BREAKFAST, DINNER)

After breakfast, a **local guide** will board our coach and share with us information on the history, geology, flora and fauna of Grand Canyon National Park. We will stop several times to enjoy incredible vistas of the canyon.

Afterward, we depart and head south to **Sedona, AZ**. We'll drive through scenic **Oak Creek Canyon** and as we approach Sedona, situated amidst gorgeous, towering red-hued rocks, you will soon understand why it has been recognized as America's most beautiful western town. After free time to explore in town, we will check in for two nights at the **Courtyard by Marriott**. Cradled among the stunning red rocks, the hotel offers easy access to all things Sedona.

Take time to relax before we depart for a delicious dinner at a local favorite, **Javelina Cantina**.

MONDAY, JUNE 7 (BREAKFAST, DINNER)

After breakfast we will take off on a **jeep tour** into the heart of Sedona's red rocks, only accessible via off-road trails. This easy-going trail ride is the perfect excursion to experience Sedona off-road. Afterward, we'll make a stop at **Tlaquepaque Village**. Authentically fashioned after a traditional Mexican village, enjoy free time to explore the unique shops and myriad of restaurant offerings in this artist community.

Back at the hotel, enjoy some time to relax, take a dip in the pool or stretch your legs on hiking trails that lead directly from the hotel's door. Sedona is believed to be a place of powerful spiritual energy. Later this afternoon, a **local guide** will teach us about it's energy vortexes and the city's colorful history on a **city tour**.

Tonight we will enjoy a final dinner together at a local restaurant.

TUESDAY, JUNE 8 (BREAKFAST)

After breakfast, it's time for us to head to the **Phoenix Airport** for our return flight home. We'll be taking with us fond memories of the beautiful sites and fun activities we experienced journeying from the *Rockies to Red Rocks!*
